The conference gave all participants a unique and valuable opportunity to meet our honourable guest, Anna Mae Tuazon, Senior Officer in charge of monitoring, surveillance, and coordination within ASEAN Integration Monitoring of ASEAN Secretariat, who shared her success story and motivated the delegates to be passionate and active in their actions to solve the global issues.

The first MUN held at NHJS has truly been successful as three of our delegates, Putri Aimee Srijaya (Year 9), Nadine Kei Inara and Jasmine Ivanna Kurniawan (Year 8) have been awarded as the Honorable Mentions in their respective committees for their excellent participation in the discussions.
