NH Debate Teams Moves on to WSC Globals in Kuala Lumpur

After the NH Debate Club's successful stint in Yale University last year, a new batch of debaters has once come back victorious from the Regional Round of the World Scholar's Cup (WSC) held at the Sinarmas World Academy last April 25-26, 2015. All nine teams from NH will be moving on to the Global Rounds in Kuala Lumpur, June 22-26.

The teams competed in two divisions (senior and junior) with four events (debate, writing, bowl and challenge) which spanned six subject areas. The junior team composed of Bryan Setiawan, Daniel Hariman and Geoffrey Budiman from Secondary 2 ranked fourth overall and first for bowl, while the senior team composed of Samantha Hartono (Secondary 2), Arthur Tanjaya (Secondary 3) and Kenneth Setiadi (Junior College 2) ranked fifth overall, top 2 debate team, also winning overall top individual awards finishing at thirteenth, eighth and third places respectively. The junior team composed of Dave Tirtariyadi, Aileen Indra and Felice Pudya (Secondary 2) finished at eighth place, with Aileen Indra winning top two debater in junior division.
