

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IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Happy New Year to everyone!

A new year always brings new hopes and opportunities. May all our students remember the lessons from their past mistakes and use them to accomplish their targets for the remaining half of the year.

As we have just opened for the second semester this Monday, 9 January 2023, we would like to inform everyone these important notes and reminders, in an effort to encourage everyone to start the semester right:

Health and Safety Protocols

We will continue to ensure the safety for all through mask wearing and hand sanitisation. As usual, students should follow these protocols and temperature-taking will still be done upon entry.

Please be mindful if you have any flu-like symptoms. It is advised that you stay home, take a test to check or visit a doctor.

Visitors to the school will no longer be required to do an Antigen Rapid Test except for those who had travelled overseas in the last 3 days.

Punctuality

All students should be in school by/before 7:10 am in time for the morning routines. Students who arrived beyond 7:15 am will be marked down late and will be given a late slip.

Attendance

If a student needs to take an extended Leave of Absence before or after an official school break, a written note from one parent explaining the reason for the request is required to be submitted to the Principal. Students who are absent due to illness will be given consideration for their missed lessons and assessments as long as they have prior communication to the school and have the necessary supporting documents, e.g., doctor's/medical certificate.

Counting of late-coming infraction of students will be reset every semester, not every term.





IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Personal Appearance

Upon school entry, the following should be followed:

Hair

- No highlights or dyes, other than the natural hair colour, is allowed
- Girls need to tie their hair neatly using black or blue hair elastics or use hair bands
- Boys are not allowed to have their hair tied in a bun. If this is the case, their hair should be cut according to

the appropriate length permitted by the school.

Girls' Uniform

- White blouse with school crest
- School tie (for Secondary/JC)
- Grey skirt (primary/secondary) and cream skirt (JC) worn to the middle of the knee
- A pair of NHJS white or black socks and must be able to see (ankle socks are not allowed)
- Black or predominantly black (90%) shoes (no other shades or colours and boots are not allowed)

Girls may wear:

- a wrist watch
- a chain with cross or religious medallion may be worn under the blouse line
- one pair of small, simple designed studs for earrings

[Note : There should only be one earring in each ear and only in the lobe. Dangling earrings are not permitted.]

Boys' Uniform

- White school shirt with crest on the pocket tucked in neatly
- Grey pants (Primary/Secondary) and cream long pants (JC)
- School tie (for Secondary/JC)
- A pair of NHJS white or black socks and must be able to see (ankle socks are not allowed)
- Black or predominantly black (90%) shoes (no other shades or colours and boots are not allowed)

Boys may wear:

- A wrist watch
- •A chain with cross or religious medallion may be worn under a shirt line.

During PE Lessons, all students are required to be in their PE attires.

PE Attire (Girls and Boys)

- Black uniform shorts
- NHJS sports T-shirt
- White socks
- Towel
- Sport shoes [Ex: cross trainers]

Students have to bring their water bottles and name them.

Important Note: Teachers-on-duty assigned in the school entrances will have the authority to deny students' entry should they see evident infractions.

Dear all,

Greetings for the season and good health!

We hope everyone is well rested during the holidays and recharged for the next lap.

This Semester will be an exciting semester with Term 3 filled with exciting activities such as celebratory events, academic subject weeks, SC-organised activities and the like. To gain the best mileage from these activities will require us to commit ourselves to participate actively in them.

To start the term, our Year 10 students signed up and joined the SUSS-PIAGET Impact Start-up Challenge, which is taking place in NHJS after a hiatus of two years due to the pandemic. We will maintain our position that players representing our school in any competition must be exemplary and disciplined.
