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## DEAN'S ARTICLE

开斋节的假期刚过，再次恭祝所有穆斯林的同事和学生新年快乐。

十年级至十二年级的学生也开始了剑桥O水准与A/AS水准的考试，在这里预祝他们考试顺利。

这一次我想要分享一些带学生到国外交流感想，在第四学段第四周，我和Mr.Josh 带领了15位八年级的学生与新加坡丹绒加东中学 (Tanjong Katong Secondary School)的师生们交流。虽然只是短短的两天交流，但学习的动力却是满满的。这一次的交流活动主要是培养学生成为一个世界公民，尊重每个人的生活与学习背景，宗教和文化。

在这趟交流中，两校的学生不但互相分享了各自国家的文化和传统，也用热忱去感受彼此不同的学习环境，不同的文化和不同的交流方式。

在与学生做反思活动时，总结了以下几点：

### 1) 守时

时间是一种有限的资源，我们不能随意浪费它。如果我们按时开始并按时完成任务，就可以避免临时抱佛脚的情况，避免让自己和他人陷入困境中。

### 2) 舒适圈

我们需要打破舒适圈，不断尝试新的事物、学习新的知识和技能、拓展社交圈子、接触不同的文化和思想，以实现个人的发展和进步。

### 3) 理所当然与尊重

当人们对某些东西过度视为理所当然时，就会失去对其价值的认识，不懂得珍惜和感激。这种态度可能导致人们忽视细节、缺乏耐心，对其他人的贡献缺乏认可和尊重，甚至对自己的表现过于自信。例如，一个富有的人可能会认为拥有财富是理所当然的，而忽略了赚钱的过程和别人的劳动。同样，一个生活在和平和繁荣国家的人可能会认为和平和安全是理所当然的，而忽略了这种状态是需要政府和社会共同维护的。

### 4) 责任感

为了培养责任感，我们应该从小事做起，比如遵守承诺、关注他人需要、勇于承担责任等。同时，我们还应该时刻提醒自己，不断反思自己的行为，寻找不足之处，并努力改进。这是一种自律的培养。

要让孩子们从错误中学习，并一步一步学习道理，明白道理、讲道理，培养出得理饶人的美德。

## “ DEAN’S ARTICLE

Just after the holiday of Hari Raya Idul Fitri 1444 H, I would like to once again wish all Muslim colleagues and Muslim students to fill your hearts with peace, happiness, and be granted with endless blessings!

Year 10 to Year 12 students also begun their Cambridge O-Levels and A/AS-Level exams. I wish them all the best in their exams.

This time, I would like to share some thoughts and insights on taking students abroad for immersion programs. In week 4, Mr. Josh Lim and I led 15 Year 8 students to have immersion with students and teachers from Tanjong Katong Secondary School in Singapore. Although it was only a short two-day programme the motivation for learning was evident. The main objective of this programme was to cultivate students into global citizens, to respect everyone’s lives and to learn backgrounds, religions, and cultures.

During this programme, students from both schools not only shared each other’s cultural traditions, but also enthusiastically experienced different learning, cultures, and ways of communication.

During the reflection activities with the students, the following points were summarized:

### **1. Punctuality**

Time is a limited resource, and we cannot waste it at will. If we start and finish tasks on time, we can avoid the last-minute rush and avoid putting ourselves and others in a difficult situation.

### **2. Comfort Zone**

We need to step out of our comfort zone, constantly try new things, learn new knowledge and skills, expand our social circle, and get in touch with different cultures and ideas to achieve personal growth and progress.

### **3. Taking Things for Granted and Respect**

When people take things for granted, they will lose their understanding of its value and fail to cherish and appreciate it. This attitude may lead people to neglect details, show impatience, fail to recognize and respect the contributions of others, and even be overly confident about their own performance. For example, a wealthy person may take his wealth for granted, and ignore the process of earning money and other people’s labor. Similarly, a person living in a peaceful and prosperous country may disregard the peace and security they have, and ignore the fact that this state requires joint maintenance by the government and society.

### **4. Sense of Responsibility**

To cultivate a sense of responsibility, we should start with small things, such as keeping promises, paying attention to the needs of others, and being brave enough to take responsibility. At the same time, we should remind ourselves all the time, constantly reflect on our own behavior, find shortcomings, and strive to improve. This is a kind of self-discipline.

We need to let children learn from their mistakes and step by step understand the truth, speak with reason, and cultivate the virtue of being able to settle disputes with others.

## HARI PENDIDIKAN NASIONAL 2023

Assalamu'alaikum warahmatullahi wabarakatuh,  
Salam sejahtera bagi kita semua,  
Om swastiastu,

Ditetapkannya tanggal 2 Mei sebagai Hari Pendidikan Nasional oleh pemerintah Republik Indonesia melalui Keppres RI Nomor 316 Tahun 1959, merupakan wujud nyata kepedulian pemerintah akan pentingnya pendidikan di negeri ini. Penetapan Hari Pendidikan Nasional dilatarbelakangi oleh sosok yang memiliki jasa luar biasa di dunia pendidikan kita, Ki Hadjar Dewantara, yang lahir pada tanggal 2 Mei 1889.

Peringatan Hari Pendidikan Nasional yang diselenggarakan pada setiap tanggal 2 Mei tidak semata-mata dimaksudkan untuk mengenang hari kelahiran Ki Hadjar Dewantara selaku Bapak Perintis Pendidikan Nasional, namun lebih merupakan sebuah momentum untuk kembali menumbuhkan rasa patriotisme dan nasionalisme bagi seluruh insan pendidikan.

Salah satu upaya yang dilakukan pemerintah untuk mewujudkan tujuan tersebut adalah dengan menetapkan pelaksanaan Upacara Bendera dalam rangka memperingati Hari Pendidikan Nasional. Hal ini dimaksudkan agar semua insan pendidikan mengingat kembali filosofi dari nilai perjuangan Ki Hadjar Dewantara dalam menegakkan fondasi pendidikan di Indonesia.

Tema Hari Pendidikan Nasional tahun 2023 adalah “Bergerak Bersama Semarakkan Merdeka Belajar”. Tema ini diusung agar Merdeka Belajar sebagai pendekatan agar siswa dapat memperoleh pembelajaran yang diminatinya. Hal ini beriringan dengan pengoptimalan belajar yang bisa didapatkan ketika mereka menyukai pelajaran.

Dengan ini menerangkan kepada kita semua untuk tetap semangat dalam meneruskan perjuangan pahlawan dalam hal keilmuan di Indonesia. Sebagai pelajar, bagian dari warga negara Indonesia diperlukan kesadaran dalam memaknai Hari Pendidikan dengan menghormati jasa Bapak Pendidikan Nasional dan juga para guru dengan terus bersemangat dalam saat belajar dan ikut serta berkembang agar kualitas pendidikan yang kita punya semakin baik.
